ICPPA 2026 will be held in a **hybrid format**, offering both in-person and virtual attendance options. Platform presenters must attend the meeting in person. Posters may be presented virtually or in person.

Please submit an abstract for an original presentation or poster no later than **January 22, 2026**.

Insights from structural, functional, and molecular imaging studies
- **Treatment Approaches**
Restitutive, compensatory, partner-inclusive, conversation-based, and psychosocial interventions
- **Lived Experience**
Perspectives of people with PPA/related disorders and their families, including quality of life and caregiving
- **Innovative Models of Care**
Multidisciplinary, community-based, technology-enhanced care delivery; linguistic and cultural adaptations

ICPPA 2026 Abstract Submission Guidelines

You will need the following information:

- 1) Submission Title (text box; 200 characters max)
- 2) Abstract (text box; 500 words maximum):
 - The abstract should include the following sections: Introduction; Aims; Methods; Results; Discussion.
 - Table/figure (optional) may be uploaded as .docx or .pdf.
 - Up to three references may be listed (text box).
- 3) Select Platform or Poster
 - Platform presentations consist of a 15-minute talk followed by a 5-minute question, answer, and discussion period.
 - In-person poster sessions last 90 minutes. The presenting author is expected to stand with and discuss the poster for the duration of the session.
 - Remote poster presenters will submit a digital version for online display and may also submit a physical copy for display at the meeting (optional).
